Getting to Prato

From Florence Airport A. Vespucci to Prato, bus stop: Piazza San Marco (5 minutes to the museum and hotel).

Florence Airport is approximately 25 minutes by taxi or 40 minutes by bus to Prato. There is a bus service operated by CAP bus company (timetable on www.prato.capautolinee.it) which departs every 15 minutes, located just outside the airport area on the main street. Tickets can be purchased either from newsagent or on board the bus.

From Pisa Airport G. Galiei to Prato

BY TRAIN Pisa Airport is approximately 1 hour and 50 minutes to Prato by train. You must go to Pisa Central Train Station by shuttle, then take the train to Prato. Notice that you will change train at Firenze Rifredi Station (Florence). Timetable and info at www.trenitalia.com.

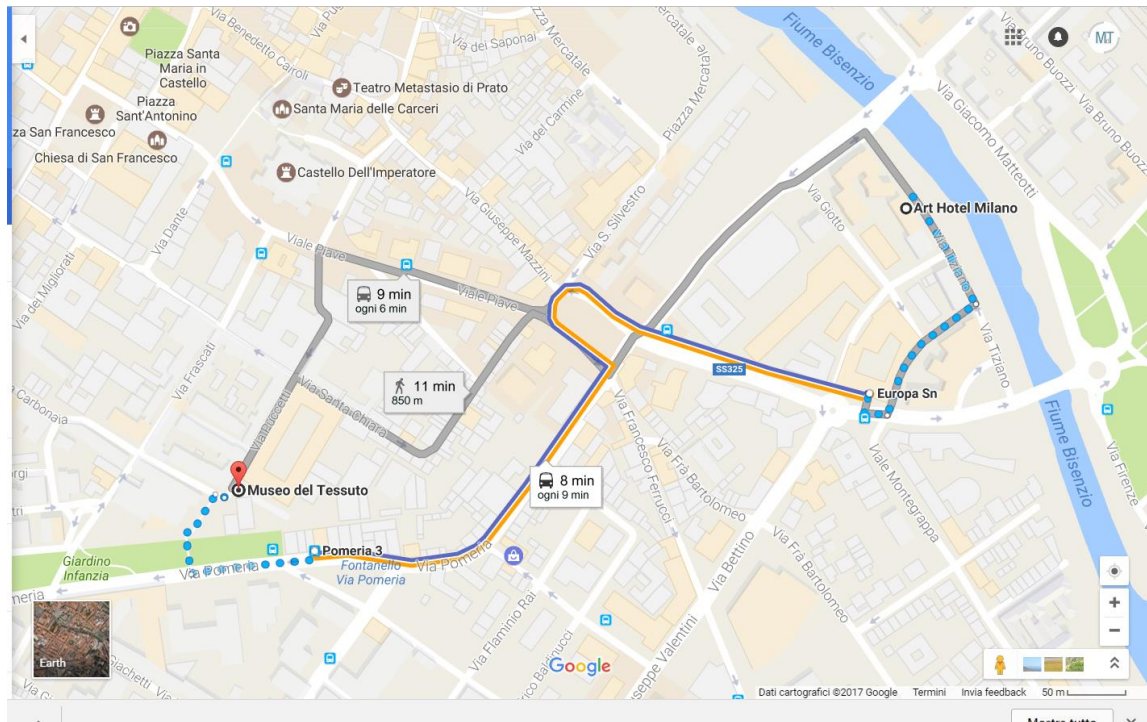
