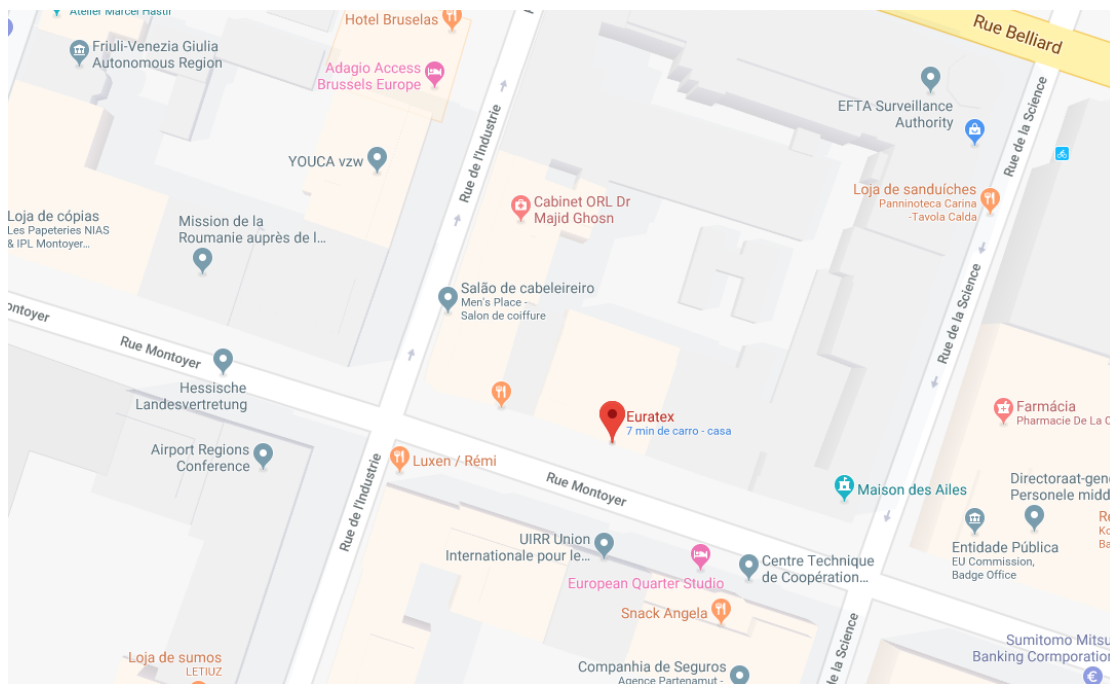

HOW TO GET TO EURATEX from the airport

Rue Montoyer, 24, 1000 Bruxelles



Taxi

15-30 min depending on traffic situation (Approx. 40€)

Train

The airport train station is located in the terminal building (level -1). Up to 4 trains an hour connect the airport to Brussels North, Brussels Central and Brussels Midi/Zuid stations. Get off at Gare Centrale and then take the metro to reach Euratex (info available on request).

Bus

The bus station is located on level 0 of the airport (one floor down from the Arrivals hall). The 'Airport Line' is a 30-40 minutes express bus service between Brussels airport and Schuman/Luxembourg area. Get off at Luxembourg square (terminus). 3 min walk to Euratex and Hotel Leopold.

Bus 12 runs from Monday to Friday, until 8 p.m.
